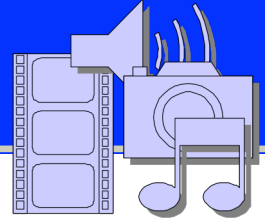


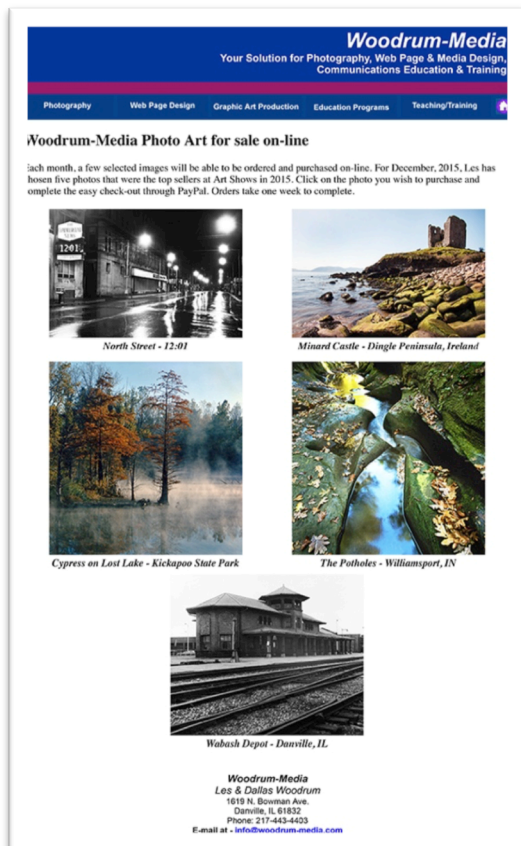

The First five photos available on-line include:

- **North Street - 12:01**
Photographed in 1986 at part of a nationwide project titled "One Day USA." The photo was featured on the Table of contents page in the book that was produced from the project.

- **Minard Castle - Dingle Peninsula, Ireland**
Photographed during recent trip to Ireland. The Minard Castle is on Dingle Bay just a few miles west of the Village of Dingle.
- **Cypress Trees on Lost Lake - Kickapoo State Park**
One of the most popular photos sold in the Leslie A. Woodrum Collection. Photographed in 1986, it is still a top seller today.
- **The Potholes - Williamsport, IN**
Another one of the most popular photos sold in the Leslie A. Woodrum Collection. Photographed in 2008, it is still a top seller today.
- **The Wabash Depot, Danville, IL**
Photographed in 1977, but negative was recently found when I had a request for "Historical Photos" of Danville. This Depot which was torn down about 35 years ago was the location where Abraham Lincoln gave his last speech in the State of Illinois on his trip to Washington D.C. to become President.

Photography "THE BASICS"

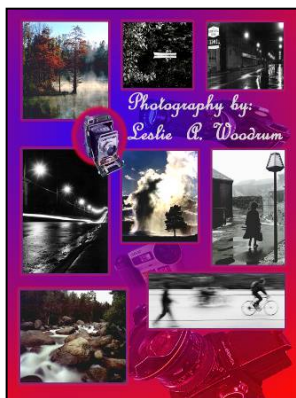
Requirements: digital camera with interchangeable lens and/or 35mm film camera

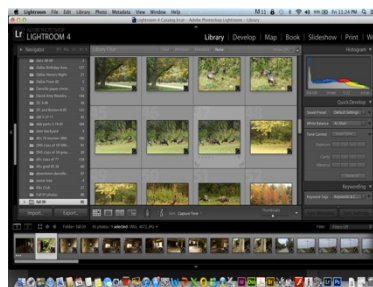


PHOTOSHOP CS

This class will introduce you to the basics of working with Photoshop CS for retouching photographic images. Students will be able to use techniques for selecting images in order to edit and retouch images, and prepare images for inclusion in a website or for printed documents. Students will be able to edit images using the painting tools, clone stamp and drawing

tools, and they will be able to create new images using the pen tool and the drawing and painting tools. Participants will be able to create and edit images using layers and make photo composites and montages.

Adobe Lightroom

New Class offered at DACC

Lightroom provides a comprehensive set of digital photography tools, from powerfully simple one-click adjustments to cutting-edge advanced controls. Create images that inspire, inform, and delight. Besides cataloging and editing your photos, there are many retouching and photo manipulations that can be performed with this rather inexpensive program.

Photoshop Elements

Photoshop Elements is a program that comes with many new digital cameras and scanners. It can perform many of the functions that the more expensive Photoshop CS5 or CS6 can do, but is more user friendly to amateur artists and photographers. The class will teach how to view and organize, fix, and enhance photos, and produce photo creations and composites.

PHOTOGRAPHY: "Photo II - Intro to Professional Photography"

This course of study introduces the student to the basics of studio and commercial photography. Classes will explore photojournalism, studio photography, commercial advertising photography and scenic art photography.

Business issues such as resale, zoning, state sales tax and income tax reporting will also be covered.

Weekly photo assignments and photo critiques are a part of the curriculum. Participants will need to produce 2-3 8x10 photos each week to complete weekly assignments. A camera, either digital or film with interchangeable lenses and a flash hot shoe is required.

There is a discount for additional prints from the same file. Lab turn-around time is two working days for un-mounted prints and three working days for prints mounted on stretcher frames.
